## Finished Size (5mm beads)

64 x 62 beads = 12.6 x 12.2 in (32.0 x 31.0 cm)

*Lay beads on a pegboard, then fuse with an iron under parchment paper. Bead colors are the nearest Perler match — swap freely.*
