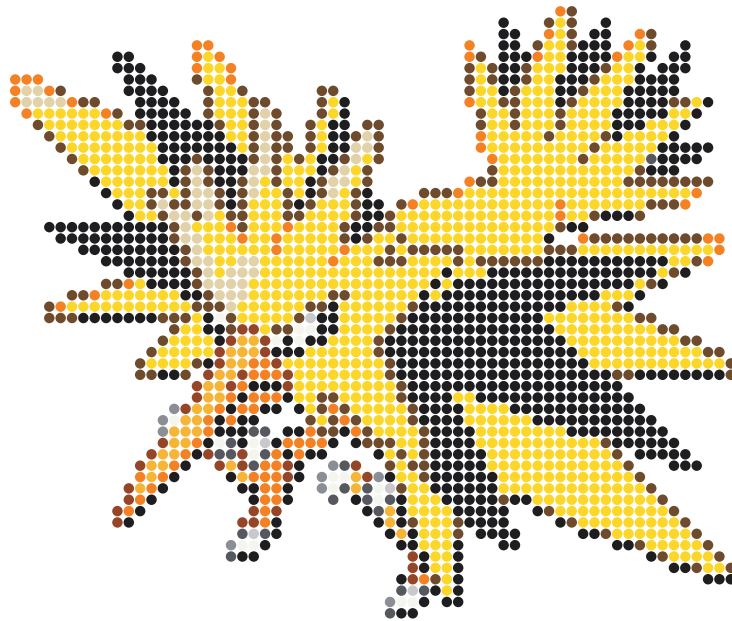


Zapdos #0145 — Perler Bead Pattern

Finished Size (5mm beads)

64 x 54 beads = 12.6 x 10.6 in (32.0 x 27.0 cm)

Lay beads on a pegboard, then fuse with an iron under parchment paper. Bead colors are the nearest Perler match — swap freely.

Chart — 64 x 54 (bold lines every 10)
